

Public Entertainment Licence Conditions

1. Health and Safety – The licenceholder shall comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Etc. Act 1990 and with all other relevant legislation in connection thereto.
2. General Fire Precautions – All requirements of the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) relating to fire precautions and safety shall be implemented, and in particular, the licenceholder shall ensure that there are adequate and suitable means for fighting fire, and that the means of escape from the premises are kept free from obstruction at all times.
3. Control of Noise – The operation of the premises shall be conducted so as not to cause a noise nuisance in terms of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, and any other similar legislation related to control of noise, and in particular, the licenceholder shall modulate all amplified music within the premises to the specification of West Lothian Council's Environmental Health & Trading Standards manager.
4. Access to Authorised Officers – Any SFRS officer, police constable or authorised officer of West Lothian Council shall be permitted free access to the whole of the premises at any time and all reasonable directions and requirements of such officers or West Lothian Council must be complied with.
5. Residual Current Devices – Where portable electrical appliances are to be used in premises which are not fitted with earth leakage systems, residual current devices must be connected to the appliances.
6. Access and Egress – Fire exits must not be used for any other purpose other than emergency egress from the premises.
