A Written West Lothian Council Local Plan Public Response Statement

Your ref. LDP/1/SMcL/KW.

You may be aware of the above. p.a.w.l. is a body of local people with widespread support from councillors, walkers and friends in the public. We fully intend to continue until the completion is made of the "Old Drove Road" in West Lothian Having already completed all required signs in Falkirk and in Borders, we will provide zero council finance for signs, high safety and high historical integrity route across West Lothian.

The point of this contribution to the local plan public consultation-having already given evidence in the past- is the following-

That since 12 "Old Drove Road" sign stickers in February 2012 were fixed to existing signs by West Lothian Council between the south-east corner of Beecraigs and the Linlithgow Manse Road canal bridge, thus becoming part of the official infrastructure of West Lothian no mention has been made of this in print in any seen West Lothian documents, including the local plan or the core paths plan. This is therefore a wrong misrepresentation of the position on the ground as per these plans. The reasons for this exclusion are unknown. We now ask that this exclusion be rectified by inclusion in these and other public documents.
