

WEST LoTHIAN COUNCIL'S LATE HOURS CATERING POLICY

With effect from 7 August 2012 the Council's policy in relation to Late Hours Catering licences is –

1. Applications for LHC licences for petrol stations, supermarkets and retail shops

In the absence of any objections, representations or adverse comments from either the public or the Council's advisors, applications to licence the above premises between the hours of 11pm and 5am will be granted under delegated authority by the Chief Solicitor. All other applications will be referred to the Licensing Committee for a decision to be taken.

2. Applications for LHC licences for takeaway or restaurant premises

In the absence of any objections, representations or adverse comments from either the public or the Council's advisors applications to licence takeaway or restaurant premises will be granted with a terminal hour of 1am for sales at the premises and 2am for deliveries. All other applications will be referred to the Licensing Committee for a decision to be taken.
