Dear Sir,

I would like to object in the strongest possible terms to your proposed development off [REDACTED] by Cala Homes. I live at [REDACTED] and am very much aware of the traffic coming into and going out of the [REDACTED] at peak times. There is only one way in and out of this estate and all the traffic needs to pass my house. At tea time it can almost be constant. In winter it can be horrendous for traffic coming up the hill out of [REDACTED]. All of this makes it extremely hazardous for children in the estate. Nobody seems to have given any thought to this.

Preston Road itself isn't much better, the road already has speed bumps to control the speed of cars up and down the hill (it does nothing to slow lorries, buses and vans) and at school opening and closing it becomes a virtual car park, more cars from this proposed development will only make it worse and is, even at this time, an accident waiting to happen. The junction at the bottom of Preston Road opposite the 'Black Bitch' is particularly bad at peak times and will only get worse with the additional traffic, as the proposed development's distance from shops is so far away it can only mean more traffic.

The schools themselves are at their limit at the present time, what are you going to do at these schools to provide more places in the two primaries and the Academy?

Finally, can I say that it is a bit suspicious that the Council have redrawn the greenbelt plans to the exact plans of Cala Homes and ignored my and other's previous objections. If this development goes ahead, I think I for one will be calling for an inquiry as there definitely seems to be some collusion here.
