Dear Sir/Madam,

We wish to register our objection for H-LV-3 and would like this area to be de-zoned for any future housing.

Previously there was a recommendation by an independent planning consultant commissioned by the community council to WLC that if legally possible, this site should be de-allocated for development on the grounds that there remains a grave concern on the high level of toxic waste on this site and the impact it would have for the residents in Murieston.

Also in 2009, WLC made a tree preservation for the trees on this land stating 'The character of the said trees is of high conservation value and contribute to the appearance and quality of the environment in the area to a significant extent, retention of the trees is required to protect the setting of the area'

On a very personal note as a resident whose property is on the boundary of this land I am finding this all very stressful to think, if this piece of land is granted for future development, we will have to go through the whole objection process again, which seems completely ludicrous as nothing has changed from previously with this land - all the same health and social responsibilities issues remain the same.
