Proposed Development Site H-LV 3 : Murieston South (8) Tarbert Drive

I refer to the above proposal and to the correspondence I received informing me of the proposal to develop this land and wish to object to this proposal and ask that consideration is given to the previous applications to develop and subsequent refusal.

I have lived in my property since the house was built in 2002 and have been subjected to frequent stress and worry as a result of the owner of this land attempting to gain planning permission for a piece of ground which is contaminated. There was a lengthy campaign undertaken at the last planning application submission which was appealed and the result of the appeal was to refuse the planning application in favour of the residents which took into effect the threat to our health if this contaminated ground was disturbed. Previously there was a recommendation by an independent planning consultant commissioned by the community council to WLC that, if legally possible, this site should be de-allocated for development on the grounds that there remains a grave concern on the high level of toxic waste on this site and the impact it would have for the residents in Murieston.

It is irresponsible of West Lothian Council to ignore the lengthy case history and once again subject the residents within properties in close proximity to this land to an uncertain future. This piece of land should be removed once and for all from the list for Proposed Development Sites and the residents surrounding the area should be able to live in their homes with the knowledge that this land will not be considered for development. The risk to our health is far greater and far more important than the financial gain to the council should this land be developed.
