

This is a hunting ground for kestrels. (In fact, there was one here this morning - 17-11-15 at 9am). There is no similar area of scrub and rough grassland in the area so it would be a pity to destroy this habitat.

① I do not have a dog but I see lots of people walking their dogs on this land. Building here would result in loss of this amenity.

② I have a good view of my old school and the area beyond. I would not care to lose it.

④ Added traffic on Kirk Road and Crosshill Drive does not matter because these are main feeder routes. However, people in Haug Crescent, Wallace Road and Veterans' Cottages may be inconvenienced by vehicles belonging to homeowners, delivery people, council, and services.
