I am making this submission as an individual and these are my views. This is my first representation on the proposed plan.

I submit emphatic objection to the proposal to build over 60 houses on the above site. My predominant reasons for objection are:-

- 1. The loss of **greenbelt** and habitat to many breeds of wildlife and protected species including bats and badgers.
- 2. Increased road traffic on Preston Road the increased risk of accidents near 3 of the towns schools, this is also a narrow road that consistently runs out of capacity especially with the schools
- 3. Increase of pressure on school places which are already over subscribed
- 4. Pressure on the health services
- 5. The loss of a Grade A historic site this is not sensible placement
- 6. Loss of an area of outstanding natural beauty
- 7. Increased traffic on an already dangerous and hampered High Street
- 8. Increased lighting and noise and air pollution an estate of this size would bring
- 9. Air, noise and water pollution a house construction site would create
