Murieston South(8), Tarbert Drive.

H-LV3 Tarbert Drive Murieston Valley Livingston. The proposal to develop this site was rejected by the Scottish Government's Directorate for Planning and Environmental Appeals Ref: PPA-400-284 3rd April 2009 and currently has a Tree Preservation applicable. The Community Council therefore contend the inclusion of this site in the proposed plan in inappropriate and will oppose any development within this site.

Livingston Other Developments:

Page Number: 92, 278,

P-101 South Murieston / Linhouse distributor road.

It is assumed that the function of this road is to provide potential access to E-LV 46 (Linhouse) employment. The Community Council considers the extension of this road from E-LV 46 to Murieston Road is unnecessary and inappropriate, the road from Oakbank Industrial Park to E-LV 46 should be terminated within E-LV 46. Consequently the Community Council will oppose development of this road west of E-LV 46
