Dear Sirs,

I am a resident at [REDACTED] and I would like to object to the proposed development at Manse Road and South Oatlands Park. I would object on the following reasons:-

1. I was at a meeting at Linlithgow High School prior to its expansion. At that time the school was already under pressure to meet demand for places even with the higher capacity. I do not see how a further 45 houses will help with this. As far as I am aware the new school at Winchburgh has yet to be built and even then, there will continue to be a high demand for places at the Academy. The local primary schools are also under pressure.

Further, the capacity of local amenities such as the sports centre and doctors surgery will be put under further pressure.

2. The proposed development site is a greenfield site beyond the current settlement boundary.
3. The development site is prime agricultural land and I believe it should be retained as such.
4. Should development have to take place there is brownfield land to the west of Linlithgow which could be considered rather than using agricultural land.
