SEPA campaign messages, June 2016

Are you complying with your legal duty to separate materials for recycling?

A new SEPA campaign will target waste producers to raise awareness of how to stay within the law when it comes to the duty to recycle. This campaign is supported by SEPA's new enforcement measures, which include the potential to issue a £300 fixed monetary penalty (FMP), for persistent failure to comply with the duty to segregate material for recycling.

FMPs won't be used in isolation. They will work alongside our existing enforcement actions (e.g. advice and guidance, final warning letters, enforcement notices and reports to the Procurator Fiscal) to change the behaviour of offenders and drive them towards full compliance.
