

Bulky Uplift Number of Items Guidance

2 door wardrobe – 1 item

Please dismantle into a manageable bundle



3 door wardrobe - 2 items

Please dismantle into 2 manageable bundles



4 door wardrobe (if doors are mirrored these must be taped) - 3 items

Please dismantle into 3 manageable bundles



Mirrored Wardrobe – 3 items

Please dismantle into 3 manageable bundles, doors must be taped

If it is the doors alone (for example from a fitted wardrobe frame with sliding doors) it would be 1 item **if** the doors were taped together but 2 if the doors were presented separately.



Over bed unit wardrobe - 3 items

Please dismantle into 3 manageable bundles and tape any mirrors



Divan bed base (whatever size of bed) – 1 item



Headboard - 1 item

If fabric, please keep dry



Mattress 1 item

Please keep dry



Bed frame (metal or wood) 1 item

Please dismantle into a manageable bundle; the mattress would be a separate item



Sideboard – 1 item



Dresser (small) 1 item



Dresser (medium) – 1 item




Dresser (large) – 2 items

Please try to split the top unit from the bottom unit



Bookcase – 1 item



Trampoline

Please dismantle and present poles and net as a bundle

8ft. – 1 item

10 ft. – 2 items

12 ft. – 2 items

14 ft. – 3 items



Fence Panels

Less than 6ft tall and 6ft wide. 1 panel is 1 item.



Sofas – Please keep dry

A sofa is 1 item if it is kept whole. If it is cut/separated into parts each part will be an item.



Corner Sofas – Please keep dry

A corner sofa which separates into 2 pieces would be 2 items

A corner sofa which separates into 3 pieces would be 3 items and so on.
