In order to process your Library Membership, to enable access to and borrowing of library resources, such as books, multi-media, pcs etc. and to record statistics of use, how often the service is used and provide basic demographic information.

We provide a library service in accordance with the following legislation.

YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION AND HOW IT WILL BE USED

Under data protection law, the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- We need it to perform a public task – to provide a library service, process and maintain your library membership. To provide public use of computers and internet access and to record participants in library events and groups.

YOUR RIGHTS

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access

You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification

You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure	You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.
Your right to restriction of processing	You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.
Your right to object to processing	You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances
Your right to data portability	You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
