










Q1. How often do you use East Calder Park?




75% of respondents use the park at least once a week

Existing grass pitches swapped, new direct path and 3G pitch rotated




Q6. Please have a look at the draft layout options from the landscape architect and let us know what you think of these initial ideas. Does any option stand out as most preferable? If so, please say why...

Option 1	6	More variety
Option 2	13	Keep 3G away from houses / nice planting / paths through middle of park / significant natural space
Option 3	11	Keep 3G away from housing / best access routes / keeps current layout / multi-use site / more green outwith pitches / possible reduced 3G / straight path and planting
Option 4	11	More accessible / nice planting / lots plants and trees by Burn / some open spaces not devoted to sports / more trees and shrubs / better connectivity
No preference	13	All options OK
No preference	15	Not sure why 3G pitch is needed / too much space for football
No preference	11	I like the football pitches / 3G pitches will be great / 3G pitch and football changing rooms
