

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION 12 DECEMBER 2019

LIVINGSTON CONSTITUENCY

I, Graham Hope, Returning Officer for the Livingston constituency declare that:

The eligible electorate was **82,285**. Turnout was **66.5%**.

The total number of votes given to each candidate was as follows:

Therefore, I give public notice that **Hannah Mary Bardell** is duly elected as the Member of Parliament for the Livingston constituency.

The total number of valid votes cast across the Livingston constituency at the UK Parliamentary General Election on 12 December 2019 was **54,592**.

The total number of ballot papers rejected was **146**.

The ballot papers were rejected for the following reasons:

0	ballot papers were rejected because they did not bear the official mark
22	ballot papers were rejected because votes were given for more than one candidate
1	ballot papers were rejected because there was something written or marked on the ballot paper by which the voter could be identified
123	ballot papers were rejected because they were unmarked or void for uncertainty
