

Find a (Re)use for those odd socks- No Sew Sock Bunnies!

Materials

- Sock
- Rice
- String
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Black marker



Instructions

1. Fill the toe and foot of the sock with rice up to the beginning of the heel. Fill the sock with enough rice so that it can stand up on its own, and makes a nice, fat bunny.
2. Once you've finished adding the rice create two rice balls by pinching off the upper-middle and tying with string, forming the head and body of the bunny.
3. Using string, tie off the top of the sock directly above the rice, forming the bunny's ears.
4. Pinch off a small ball at the back of the bunny and tie using string to create the bunny's tail.
5. Fluff and adjust the sock as necessary.
6. Cut the top of the sock in half to form the bunny's two ears. Continue to carefully cut, snip and trim away the extra fabric to form two even, oval bunny ears.
7. Tie the ribbon in a bow around the second string, at the bunny's "neck" between the head and body.
8. Use the marker to draw a face on the bunny's head by making two little dots for the eyes, and an "X" for the mouth.
