SCREENING DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 8(1)

West Lothian Council has determined on 8 May 2020, in consultation with Historic Environment Scotland, the Scottish Environment Protection Agency and Scottish Natural Heritage, that Planning Guidance 'Mobile Snack Bars' is unlikely to have significant environmental effects when considered in relation to the criteria set out under Schedule 2 of the Act. It has therefore been concluded that Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is not required. No environmental report will be prepared alongside the Planning Guidance relating to 'Shopfronts and advertisements in Broxburn and Uphall, Linlithgow, Kirknewton, Livingston Village, Mid Calder and Torphichen Conservation Areas'.
