

DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS

The council is enabled to require developers to mitigate the impact of their development and to pay for/contribute towards improvements to infrastructure that arise as a direct consequence of their development.

The Strategic Development Plan for Edinburgh and South East Scotland (SDP) expects West Lothian's Local Development Plan (LDP) to set out the items and circumstances in which developer contributions will be sought and Supplementary Guidance is prepared to assist applicants, landowners and developers in this regard. As a result, depending on the location and the type of development, it anticipates some developments to be the subject of developer contributions.

Local Development Plan Policies **INF 1** (Infrastructure Provision and Developer Obligations) and **CDA 1** (Development in the Previously Identified Core Development Areas) of the LDP advise that the council will seek contributions in accordance with Scottish Government Circular 3/2012 'Planning Obligations and Good Neighbour Agreements', as interpreted by emerging case law and amended by subsequent amendments and legislation, to mitigate the development's individual or cumulative impacts upon infrastructure, including cross-boundary impacts. Developer contributions are currently sought by West Lothian for the following:
