
In July/August 2022 the community was asked what their likes and dislikes were about Windyknowe Park and to suggest things that would enhance users' enjoyment of the greenspace. The results of that survey can be found on the Council's website at

A number of suggestions were put forward but due to budget and/or conflicting park uses it was not possible to implement them all. Three options were, therefore, drawn up and the community was asked to vote on their preferred option. The results are shown in the graph below.

Option 3 received the most votes. This comprises the following:

- A new whindust path from the asphalt path by the play area to the western fence;
- A new entrance, through the existing fence, from the path on the western boundary of the park;
- A new whindust path from the new entrance on the west to the fence on the southern boundary;
- A new entrance, through the existing fence, from the pavement on the southern boundary of the park;
- New park signage;
- Removal of the existing goal posts;
- 2 new goals, creating a smaller grass pitch area, in the central area of the park;
- A new basketball hoop with hard surface in the central area of the park;
- A new seat adjacent to the new path along the north of the park;
- Bulb area created adjacent to the eastern edge of the play area;

All of the above depends on quotes being received within the park budget. A decision would be made by the Open Space Officer on the items that met the community's suggestions and provided best value for money if quotes exceeded the budget.

An indicative plan of proposed works is shown below.

Quotes for the works will now be obtained. Ideally the work would be implemented in the first half of 2023.
