THE WEST LOTHIAN COUNCIL (B708 SIBBALDS BRAE, ARMADALE) (RESTRICTED ROAD) AND (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION) ORDER 2022

The West Lothian Council in exercise of their powers under sections 82 (2) and 83 (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The West Lothian Council (B708 Sibbalds Brae, Armadale) (Restricted Road) and (40mph Speed Limit) (Variation) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Twenty first day of November in the year Two Thousand and Twenty-two.
2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The West Lothian Council (B708 Bathville Armadale West Lothian) (Restricted Roads) and (B708 Bathgate to Armadale) (40mph Speed Limit) (Variation) Order 2004 shall have effect as if in the Schedule the figure "125" were deleted and there were substituted the figure "471" with the result that the schedule reads:-

LENGTH OF ROAD SUBJECT TO A SPEED LIMIT FOR FORTY MILES PER HOUR

B708 Bathgate to Armadale.

From a point 471 metres or thereby south-west of the south-western kerbline of Falside Drive, Bathgate, to a point 222 metres or thereby east of the east kerbline of Gracie's Wynd, Armadale.

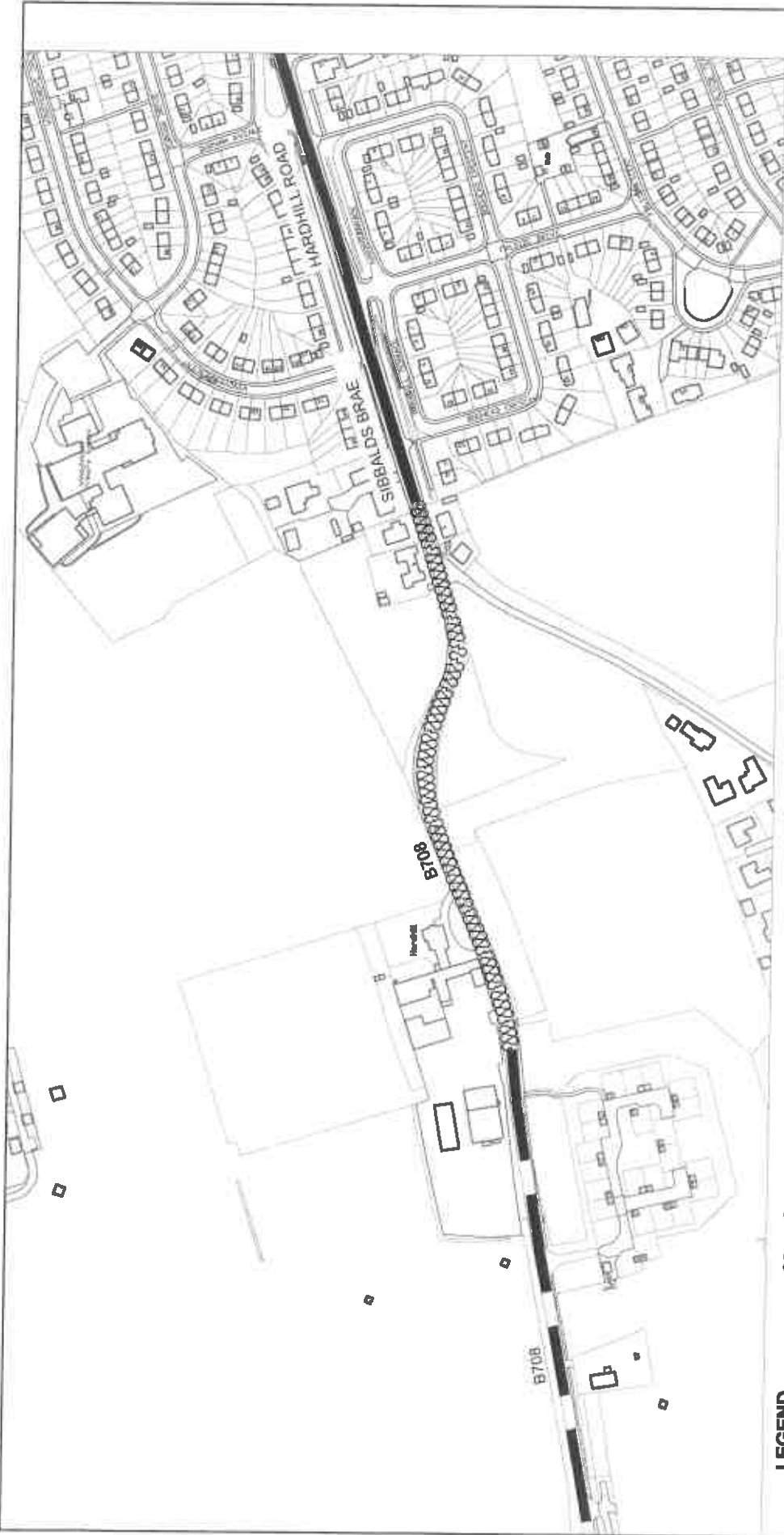
4. The following length of road shall become a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81(1) of the 1984 Act, which imposes a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on a restricted road and shall be in addition to the lengths of restricted road described in the entries in Part III of the Schedule to the Lothian Regional Council (Restricted Roads) Order 1985:-

B708 Bathgate to Armadale.

From a point 125 metres or thereby south-west of the south-western kerbline of Falside Drive, Bathgate, to a point 471 metres or thereby west of the south-western kerbline of Falside Drive
