  - detained under paragraph 2 of Schedule 3 to the immigration Act 1971 (deportation);
  - imprisoned, detained or in custody under the Army Act 1955, the Air Force Act 1955, or the Naval Discipline Act 1957 (subject to certain conditions).
- 3. The above paragraph does not apply to any person detained only under section 407 of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975.
