**The West Lothian Council (Broxburn) Air Quality Management Area
Revocation Order 2024**

**Order revoking the West Lothian Council (Broxburn) Air Quality Management
Area: Environment Act 1995 Part IV Section 83(2)**

Whereas West Lothian Council ("the Council") incorporated under the Local Government Etc (Scotland) Act 1994 and having its Headquarters at West Lothian Civic Centre, Howden South Road, Livingston, having caused to be conducted a review and assessment of the air quality in Broxburn, is satisfied that the air quality objectives in respect of Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂) and Particulate Matter (PM₁₀) specified in the Air Quality (Scotland) Regulations 2000 (as amended by the Air Quality (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2002 and 2016), will be met in the area shown outlined and shaded in red on map attached hereto, which area incorporates West Main Street eastwards from, but not including the junction with School Road, Buchan Land (part), Station Road (part), Easter Road (part), Dunnet Way (part), Hunter Gardens, A89 eastward from Hunter Gardens to western boundary of service station, Broxburn, all in the County of West Lothian, for reasons of previous, current and projected compliance with the relevant air quality objectives, the Council, in exercise of the power conferred upon it by Section 83(2) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Revocation Order for The West Lothian Council (Broxburn) Air Quality Management Area designated in March 2011.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Air Quality Management Area known as The West Lothian Council (Broxburn) Air Quality Management Area designated for Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂) and Particulate Matter (PM₁₀), and as shown outlined and shaded in red on the map attached hereto, shall be revoked.
2. This Order shall be cited as The West Lothian Council (Broxburn) Air Quality Management Area Revocation Order 2024
3. This Order shall come into effect on 26 January 2024
