

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

#### Underground coal mining

The property is in the likely zone of influence from workings in 1 seam of coal at 60m depth, and last worked in 1908.

Any ground movement from these coal workings should have stopped by now.

In addition the property is in an area where the Coal Authority believe there is coal at or close to the surface. This coal may have been worked at some time in the past.

The property is in the likely zone of influence from workings in 3 seams of oil shale at 40m to 490m depth, and last worked in 1961.

The property is not in the likely zone of influence of any present underground coal workings.

#### **Future**

The property is not in an area for which the Coal Authority is determining whether to grant a licence to remove coal using underground methods.

The property is not in an area for which a licence has been granted to remove or otherwise work coal using underground methods.

The property is not in an area that is likely to be affected at the surface from any planned future workings.

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However, reserves of coal exist in the local area which could be worked at some time in the future.

No notice of the risk of the land being affected by subsidence has been given under section 46 of the Coal Mining Subsidence Act 1991.

#### Mine entries
