I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 7 - Whitburn and Blackburn. There is 1 Councillor to be elected.

The electorate was 17,247 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,577 giving a percentage turnout of 20.7%. There were 35 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,772.

The number of first preference votes for each of the candidates was:
